<p>Location</p> <p>There is not a bus stop within 150m (164yds) of the venue.</p> <p>The nearest National Rail station is Cumbernauld.</p>	
<p>Venue Car Park</p> <p>Parking is free for all users.</p> <p>The car park is located at the front of the venue.</p>	

<p>The car park type is open air/surface.</p> <p>Parking spaces for Blue Badge holders do not need to be booked in advance.</p> <p>The route from the car park to the entrance is accessible to a wheelchair user with assistance.</p> <p>Assistance may be required because there is / are loose chippings.</p> <p>The car park surface is loose chippings.</p> <p>The patron does not have to cross a road.</p> <p>The car park does not have a height restriction barrier.</p> <p>On Street Parking and Drop-off Details</p> <p>There is not a designated drop off point.</p>	
<p>Comments</p> <p>There are 2, unmarked designated parking spaces for blue badge holders.</p>	
<p>Outside Access (Main Entrance)</p> <p>This information is for the entrance located at the front of the building.</p> <p>There is not level access into the venue.</p> <p>The main door(s) open towards you (pull).</p> <p>The doors are double width.</p> <p>The door(s) is / are heavy.</p>	

<p>The door opening is 140cm (4ft 7in) wide.</p>	
<p>Level Change (Main Entrance)</p> <p>There is a ramp or slope to access this service.</p> <p>The ramp or slope is located in front of the entrance.</p> <p>The ramp or slope is easy.</p> <p>The ramp or slope is permanent.</p> <p>There is a level landing at the top of the ramp.</p> <p>The ramp does not have handrails.</p>	
<p>Outside Access (Bird Of Prey Centre Entrance)</p> <p>This information is for the entrance located next to the reception.</p> <p>There is not level access into the venue.</p> <p>The main door(s) open away from you (push).</p> <p>The doors are single width.</p> <p>The door(s) is / are heavy.</p> <p>The door opening is 96cm (3ft 2in) wide.</p>	
<p>Level Change (Bird Of Prey Centre Entrance)</p> <p>There is a ramp or slope to access this service.</p> <p>The ramp or slope is located before and after</p>	

the entrance.

The ramp or slope is moderate.

The ramp or slope is permanent.

Comments

There is handrails on either side of the ramp after the entrance.



Reception

The desk is 1m (3ft 3in) from the main entrance.

There is level access to reception from the entrance.

The reception desk is medium height (77cm - 109cm).

The desk does not have a low (76cm or lower) section.

The lighting levels are medium.

There is not a hearing assistance system.

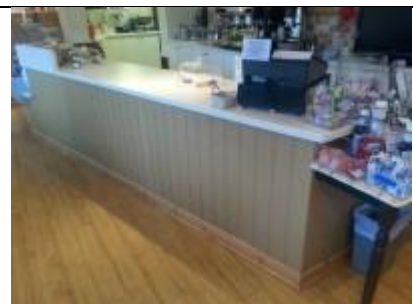








Inside Access

<p>Restaurant Bar (The Cabin Cafe)</p> <p>The following information is for the cafe.</p> <p>Full table service is available.</p> <p>No tables are permanently fixed.</p>	

No chairs are permanently fixed.

No chairs have armrests.

The nearest table is 3m (3yd 10in) from the main entrance.

The distance between the floor and the lowest table is 68cm (2ft 3in).

There is ample room for a wheelchair user to manoeuvre.

Plastic / takeaway cups are available.

Plastic / takeaway cutlery is available.

Drinking straws are available.

Menus are hand held only.

Menus are not available in Braille.

Menus are not available in large print.

Picture menus are not available.

Menus are clearly written.

Menus are presented in contrasting colours.

The type of food served here is hot and cold meals and snacks.

Accessible Toilet

Location of and access to accessible toilets

There are accessible toilets within this venue designated for public use.

The toilet is not for the sole use of disabled people.

There is pictorial signage on or near the toilet door.

The accessible toilet is located outside the front of the venue, to the left of the main entrance.

There is level access to the accessible toilet.



Features and dimensions of accessible toilets

This is a unisex toilet.

A key is not required for the accessible toilet.

The door opens outwards.

The door is locked by a sliding bolt.

The width of the accessible toilet door is 95cm (3ft 1in).

The door weight is heavy.

The dimensions of the accessible toilet are 180cm x 230cm (5ft 11in x 7ft 7in).

There is sufficient turning space in the cubicle for a wheelchair user.

There is a lateral transfer space.

As you face the toilet pan the transfer space is on the right.

The lateral transfer space is 110cm (3ft 7in).

There is a dropdown rail on the transfer side.

There is a flush on the transfer side.

The tap type is lever.

There is a mixer tap.

There is not an emergency alarm in the cubicle.

Disposal facilities are not available in the cubicle.

There is a coat hook.

The coat hook is not within 120cm (3ft 11in) from floor level.

Position of fixtures in accessible toilets

Wall mounted rails are available.

As you face the toilet the wall mounted grab rails are on both sides.

There is not a shelf within the accessible toilet.

<p>There are mirrors.</p> <p>Mirrors are placed at a lower level or at an angle for ease of use.</p> <p>The height of the toilet seat above floor level is 47cm (1ft 7in).</p> <p>There is not a hand dryer.</p> <p>There is a towel dispenser.</p> <p>The towel dispenser cannot be reached from seated on the toilet.</p> <p>The towel dispenser is not placed higher than 100cm (3ft 3in).</p> <p>There is a toilet roll holder.</p> <p>The toilet roll holder can be reached from seated on the toilet.</p> <p>The toilet roll holder is not placed higher than 100cm (3ft 3in).</p> <p>There is a sink.</p> <p>The sink cannot be reached from seated on the toilet.</p> <p>The sink is not placed higher than 74cm (2ft 5in).</p>	
<p>Colour contrast and lighting in accessible toilets</p> <p>The contrast between the external door and wall is good.</p>	

The contrast between the internal door and wall is poor.

The contrast between the grab rails and wall is good.

The contrast between the drop down rails and wall is good.

The contrast between the walls and floor is good.

The lighting levels are bright.

Baby Change Facilities

Baby change facilities are located within the venue.

Baby change facilities are located within the accessible toilet.

The height of the baby change table once extended is 95cm (3ft 1in).

Inside the venue, there is level access to the baby change facility.



Access to Standard Female and Male Toilets

The female and male toilets are located at the front of the building.

Inside the venue, there is level access to the female and male toilets.

Lighting levels are medium.
